New tuition rules

New tuition payment rules for Fall Semester 2006 require students to meet minimum payment requirements by certain dates, or their registrations will be cancelled for nonpayment. For students who have registered since Aug. 8, the tuition due date is Friday, Sept. 1.

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The tuition due date is this Friday, Sept. 1, for students who have registered since Aug. 8. Students who registered through Aug. 7 were subject to an earlier due date (Aug. 11).

Students are urged to verify their status online, by logging in to the e-services web site, www.mnsu.edu/msureg with Tech ID and PIN, and by visiting the "My Account" page found under the Student tab. Students will see either a green "GO" or red "STOP" symbol with a corresponding message indicating whether they have met the requirements. Students who see the red "STOP" symbol on their accounts are at risk of having their registrations cancelled and need to take action prior to the close of business on Friday, Sept. 1, to prevent loss of enrollment.

Faculty and staff members who know of students who have received late financial assistance through the University, such as departmental scholarships or graduate assistantships, should notify Student Financial Services by e-mail (campushub@mnsu.edu) before Thursday, Aug. 31. This will allow Student Financial Services to update its records as well as the students' status records.

The cancellation process will run mid-day Tuesday, Sept. 5. Students whose registrations are cancelled will be notified by e-mail that they are no longer enrolled. Instructors are encouraged to verify enrollment of students attending their classes upon receipt of the fifth-day rosters.

Students who wish to re-enroll after registrations are cancelled for nonpayment must submit a completed appeal for late registration to the Registration Help Desk, WA132, no later than Monday, Sept. 11. The appeal process requires students to obtain electronic permission to register from course instructors, and to remit the first installment payment for tuition/fees of at least \$300 to the Cashiers Office, WA128.
