

1,665 to graduate at spring commencement May 13

Minnesota State Mankato will graduate 1,665 students during spring commencement exercises Saturday, May 13, at Taylor Center.



Minnesota State University, Mankato will graduate 1,665 students during spring commencement exercises Saturday, May 13, at Taylor Center on campus.

Graduate-level degrees to be presented include 89 master of arts degrees, 18 master of fine arts degrees, four master of arts in teaching degrees, seven master of business administration degrees, 116 master of science degrees, eight master of science in nursing degrees, five master of music degrees and ten specialist degrees.

Awarded at the undergraduate level will be 107 bachelor of arts degrees, 24 bachelor of arts degrees, 985 bachelor of science degrees, 172 bachelor of science in teaching degrees, three bachelor of music degrees, 21 bachelor of science in electrical engineering degrees, fifteen bachelor of science in civil engineering degrees, one bachelor of science in computer engineering degrees, 32 bachelor of science in mechanical engineering and 48 associate of arts degrees.

(The number of graduates does not equal the number of degrees because some students earn more than one degree.)

Undergraduate students receiving special recognition include 114 graduating summa cum laude, 257 graduating magna cum laude, and 173 graduating cum laude.
