MEN'S SQUAD SEVENTH AT NOTRE DAME; RUNS AT CARLETON FRIDAY AFTERNOON

MANKATO, MN -- On the heels of an impressive showing at the Notre Dame Invitational last weekend, the Mankato State University men's cross country team will venture to Northfield, MN Friday for the Carleton Invitational.

Mankato State placed seventh among 34 teams in the Gold (Division II) Division at South Bend, IND Firday with 212 team points. Eastern Michigan captured the crown with 57 points.

Individually, Lindsay Brown (<u>Stillwater, MN</u>) finished among the meet's top ten, placing tenth with a time of 24:40 -21 seconds behind winner Phil Sanders of Hillsdale College (MICH).

Other Mavericks finishers and their places include: Mark Sybil rud (<u>Elysian, MN</u>) 45th; Joe Nicklay (<u>Woodbury, MN</u>) 47th; Rex Karametros (<u>Mason City, IA</u>) 49th; John Hogan (<u>Robbinsale, MN</u>) 61st; Jeff Taylor (<u>White Bear Lake, MN</u>) 63rd and Joe Vortherms (<u>Wilmont, MN</u>) 77th.

Coach Mark Schuck will take a large number of runners to Northfield Friday for the Carleton meet, which includes a junior varsity meet at 3:00 and a varsity race at 5:00. Mankato's women's team will also participate in that event, running at 4:15 p.m.

The Carleton meet will be MSU's final action prior to the Northern Intercollegiate COnference meet (October 18) in St. Cloud. Mankato State is the three-time defending NIC champion.
